

S-line forwarding trailers

Technical details at a glance:



1 Ergonomic operation via cross-lever control.

2 The hydraulic hoses are run in a hose shaft to protect the user at the operating console.

3 The cylinder is mounted on top to protect it from damage during loading.

4 A carefully conceived system of concealed hoses over the entire crane minimises downtime.

5 The Power Link System guarantees manoeuvrable crane work, more reach and lifting power.

6 The telescopic cylinder is internally mounted, protecting it from damage.

7 Folding lighting units protect lights against damage in standing timber.

8 The different braking systems offer safety when driving in the forest and on the road.

9 Screwed double frames prevent fatigue cracks which may occur in welded constructions.

10 Massive and robust front grilles for optimum safety during crane operation and when driving on public roads.

11 Space saving A-column stabilisers with concealed cylinders ensure a high degree of stability when parking.

12 Tidy and safe, the chainsaw can be stored in a holder. Canisters and small materials have their place in a storage compartment.

13 A one-man system for mechanically locking the steerable draw bar when driving on public roads.

14 Steering drawbar with protected axial piston pump.

15 Sturdy and powerful Two-cylinder slewing gear with high slewing torque.

16 Oil storage tank protected from damage and installed without restriction of visibility.

17 Operating console with non-slip standing plate, ladder and back support for optimum working safety.
